

## Aransas Pass ISD Condensed Standard Mode of Dress (SMOD) Requirements 2017-2018

<p><b>ACCEPTABLE Tops</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Polo-style shirts of any solid color</li> <li>• Full button-front dress shirt of any solid color             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Must be buttoned up, only the top button may be unbuttoned, and long sleeve cuffs must be buttoned</li> <li>○ Must be tucked in with a belt (excluding Faulk Early Childhood students)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Aransas Pass ISD Club /Organization /School /Class/University/ Military or “Spirit Shirts” in solid Purple, Gold, White, Grey, or Black</li> <li>• Solid colored turtlenecks or t-shirts may be worn under SMOD shirts only</li> </ul>	<p><b>NON-ACCEPTABLE Tops</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Muscle shirts</li> <li>• Sleeveless tops, tank tops, strapless tops, or tops that expose the midriff, back, or undergarments</li> <li>• Shirts with pictures, graphics, insignias, logos, or designer emblems visible larger than the size of a quarter</li> <li>• Tops that extend past the hips and past the wrist of relaxed arm</li> <li>• Tops with holes, tears, or cuts</li> <li>• Clothing that is oversized or undersized in whole or in part</li> </ul>
<p><b>ACCEPTABLE Bottoms</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Dockers” style slacks in Khaki or Navy</li> <li>• Straight-legged jeans in the standard 5-pocket style in one solid color Blue Denim</li> <li>• Capris style pants in Khaki, Navy, or solid color Blue Denim</li> <li>• Skirts or shorts in Khaki, Navy, or solid color Blue Denim</li> </ul>	<p><b>NON-ACCEPTABLE Bottoms</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jumpers or dresses</li> <li>• Clothing with frayed bottoms, holes, tears, or cuts</li> <li>• “Sag” and/or “bag” clothing – pants, jeans, and shorts must be properly sized and fitted at the waist, inseam, and crotch area.</li> <li>• Shorts and skirts more than 2 5/8” (dollar bill rule) above or below the knee on the front, back, or sides</li> </ul>
<p><b>ACCEPTABLE Footwear</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes with closed toes and backs</li> </ul>	<p><b>NON-ACCEPTABLE Footwear</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes with metal taps, toes, or similar devices</li> <li>• Flip flops, slides, and sandals</li> </ul>
<p><b>ACCEPTABLE Outerwear</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sweaters, sweatshirts, pullover and zippered hoodies, coats, jackets, and windbreakers in any solid color over SMOD shirts</li> <li>• Aransas Pass ISD related jackets</li> </ul>	<p><b>NON-ACCEPTABLE Outerwear</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outerwear with pictures, graphics, insignias, logos, or designer emblems visible larger than the size of a quarter</li> <li>• Hoods on outwear worn inside the building</li> </ul>
<p><b>ACCEPTABLE Hair and Accessories</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clean, well groomed, natural colored hair that does not cover the eyes</li> <li>• Clean, well groomed, natural colored facial hair – at principal’s discretion</li> <li>• Prescription eyeglasses</li> <li>• Ear piercings</li> <li>• Although polo-style shirts and “Spirit Shirts” are not required to be tucked in, if a student elects to tuck in their shirt, a belt must be worn</li> </ul>	<p><b>NON-ACCEPTABLE Hair and Accessories</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bizarre or unusual haircuts (i.e. Mohawks) or beards</li> <li>• Lines, numbers, designs, or other extreme styles carved or cut into hair or beards</li> <li>• Sunglasses, caps, hats, hoods, bandanas, and belt chains worn by a student inside the building</li> <li>• Body art (i.e. tattoos, permanent or temporary) must be covered by an article of clothing</li> <li>• Gauges and body piercing jewelry</li> <li>• Grillz (decoration on teeth)</li> </ul>

Any article that displays alcohol or drug slogans or other suggestive and inappropriate designs, including, but not limited to, those that promote or suggest or are symbolic of sex, violence, or antisocial behavior will not be allowed.

Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, Brownies, NJROTC, Health Science Program, and other legitimate, recognized student organization uniforms may be worn to school on days when they have meetings or other activities of that organization.

The district prohibits clothing or grooming that, in the principal’s judgment, may cause disruption or interference with normal school operations. Please see the Standard Mode of Dress Requirements for a complete explanation of dress code policies.
